ELIGIBILITY:

The company must be an NAM member with 1,000 or fewer employees; applications can be submitted by the company or a third party.

AWARD CRITERIA:

- Company Policy:* Is there a company policy on involvement in community service?
- Resources:* Is there a company budget for these programs? If yes, what percentage of your annual budget? Do your programs involve primarily financial contributions or primarily volunteer time, or a combination of the two? Does your company donate equipment and materials?
- Employee Participation:* Do you encourage employee participation in company-sponsored community efforts? If yes, please provide examples, *e.g.*, paid time off, compensatory time, etc.
- Company-Sponsored Programs:* Do you sponsor any community/humanitarian programs? If yes, please describe them.
- Other Company Efforts:* Has your company participated in other extraordinary community/humanitarian efforts that warrant consideration, *e.g.*, providing shelter in company facilities after a disaster, etc.?
- Relationship with the NAM:* Does your company have a working relationship with the NAM? If yes, please describe.
